GIVEN RECIPE – Class 16

Boiled Fruit Loaf Makes a 2lb Loaf

Ingredients	
6 oz sultanas	1 tsp baking powder
3 oz margarine	1/2 tsp bicarbonate of soda
4 oz sugar	¼ tsp mixed spice
¼ pint water	1 beaten egg
8 oz plain flour	
¼ tsp salt	

Method

- 1. Heat oven to 180 °C.
- 2. Put the sultanas, margarine, sugar, and water in a pan, bring to the boil and simmer for 10 mins. Leave to cool before mixing in the beaten egg.
- 3. Sieve together the Flour, Baking Powder, Bicarbonate of Soda, Mixed Spice and Salt and fold into the sultana mix.
- 4. Place in a greased and lined 2lb or 2 x 1lb loaf tin(s) and bake for 1 hour, or until a sharp knife comes out clean.
- Leave to cool in the tin and allow to cool completely before slicing. Remember, you only need to enter 2 slices for Class 16. Good Luck!
